You should not rely on Adiana for contraception for at least three months until a test confirms tubal blockage and during this time an alternate birth control must be used. It is not for those who want children, are pregnant or suspect pregnancy, have a history of pelvic infection, uterine abnormalities, tubal ligation, allergy to contrast fluid or taking immunosuppressive medicines. Rare but serious risks include but are not limited to pregnancy, including ectopic, and failure to place inserts.
